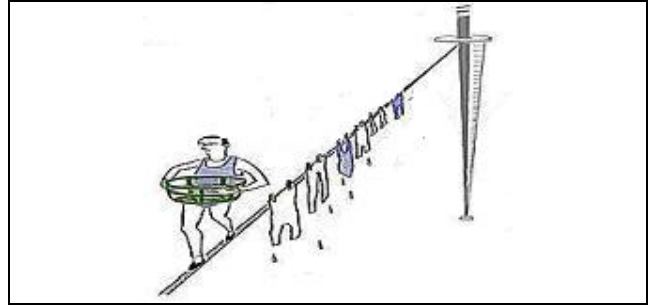


Jim's Days

But he did!














On **Thursday** he did not want
