When she was 10 she thought: " I want to be connected to all my friends and I want to take photos."




She asked her parents to buy her a phone but they said: "You're still young. You can go out to the park with your friends, you don't need a cellphone at your age".

Now Sophie is 17. She is a graffiti artist, who likes to express her feelings and thoughts not only with photos on screens but also...on walls.




