Father said, "Jennifer looks different. She is not herself. She has a fever. Jennifer, go to bed!"



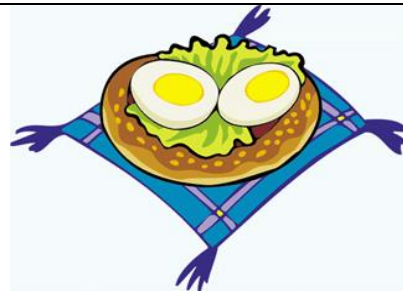
After dinner, Mother takes some food to Jennifer's bed but Jennifer is not hungry. She only drinks some water.

3x3 Matching Game

Preparation: Cut out the squares on the dotted lines only (don't cut out the triangles). Options: Glue your puzzle onto colored paper or cardboard and laminate.

To play: match the pairs, placing their edges together (the edges of their squares touching). Assemble the puzzle into a 3X3 square so that every word only touches its match, and the words at the top and bottom of each column match, and the words at the opposite ends of each row match.

(There are lots of "right ways" to assemble the puzzle.)
