

HOW TO PRONOUNCE REGULAR VERBS IN THE PAST TENSE

PRONOUNCED AS /D/ WITH NO NEW SYLLABLE

The verb ends in a vowel sound

played, agreed

OR a voiced consonant

b - dabbled m - calmed v - approved
g - hugged n - opened z - buzzed
l - called r - cared

PRONOUNCED AS /T/ WITH NO NEW SYLLABLE

The verb ends in an unvoiced consonant

c - danced gh - laughed sh - wished
ch - lunched k - thanked s - kissed
f - fluffed p - clapped x - fixed

PRONOUNCED AS /ED/ WITH A NEW SYLLABLE

The verb ends in a

d - applauded

OR a

t - chatted
