Super-Cleaner: This will not be easy. I've never seen a messier place. Have you cleaned your room even once this year?















Teenager: With Super-Cleaner's help, my bedroom was clean in no time!

### Rhyming Words Board Game

**Preparation:** Glue board and cards onto stiff paper, (laminates), cut out cards.

**Play:** Lay out the word cards face up (in rhyming groups). Place soldiers on "start." Roll a dice to advance. When you land on a word, read it aloud, and take a card from the "pot" that rhymes with it. When the first player reaches the end, whoever has the most cards wins. (Alternatively, you can play "concentration" or "Go Fish" with the rhyming card pairs alone.)
