

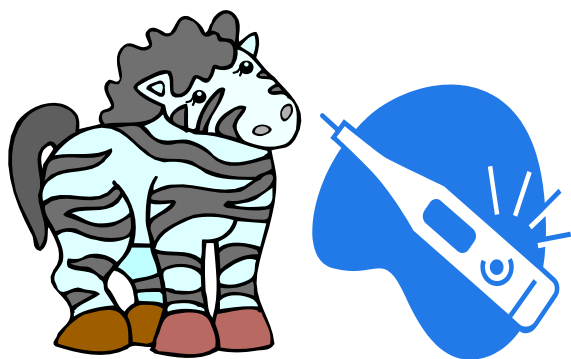
Zip the Fuzzy Zebra

Zip the Zebra Word Bingo

Materials: Bingo Board, pencil, word list

Pupil "x's" out the word when he guesses correctly.

As soon as he gets 3 in a row (vertically, horizontally or diagonally) he wins.
